We will continue to invest in our school as our students deserve the best facilities!

I was delighted with our exceptionally high headline figures for our Summer 2023 examination season. Our Year 11 leavers have made exceptional progress (provisional data), which is significantly above the national average. This is a superb achievement, especially when we all knew the Government have adjusted the GCSE standards to pre-covid levels. Many of our students have continued their educational journey with the Trust, in our Sixth Form. We wish our class of 2023 the very best in their futures.

Next Thursday, we will be holding the South Lincolnshire Academies Trust Upper School Awards Evening at the Springfield Events & Conference Centre. This will be a fantastic evening which will see our Trust celebrate the excellent Year 11 results that have been received this summer across our Trust schools.


