

- **Black blazer with Academy badge** – available **ONLY** from SA uniform shop
To be worn at all times on the school site unless specific permission has been given by a member of staff
- **Black V-neck sweatshirt/pullover** – plain black
A pullover is in addition to the blazer not instead of a blazer. No cardigans
- **Spalding Academy tie**
- **Black skirt (with Trust emblem)** - available **ONLY** from SA uniform shop
Must be no shorter than 5cm above the knee and no longer than 10cm above the ankle. Skirts must not be rolled over
- **Black trousers (with Trust emblem)** – available **ONLY** from SA uniform shop
To be worn off the ground and level with shoes
- **White shirt**
Long or short sleeved, worn tucked in and all buttons fastened (no reverse collars)
- **Black leather effect school shoes**
No trainers/pumps, no high heels
- **Socks**
Plain black short or knee length (socks must be visible above shoes - no stripes or colours and must be worn all year)
- **Tights**
Flesh coloured or black
- **Hair style**
No extreme hairstyles or colours are permitted and hair should be acceptable to public workplace. The school has discretion in these matters—please contact the school prior to colouring. No partial or shaved heads

PE KIT

- Royal blue polo shirt** (available **ONLY** from the SA Uniform Shop)
- Multi Sports Top** (available **ONLY** from SA Uniform Shop)
- Plain black shorts** (no stripes, colours or cycling shorts)
- Royal blue football socks**
- Trainers with laces and non marking soles**
- White sports socks** (trainer socks are NOT permitted)
- Football boots**
- Shin pads**
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms** (no stripes or colours)

Optional Items – to be worn ONLY for PE

- Royal blue sweatshirt** (available **ONLY** from the SA Uniform Shop)
- Plain black Skort** (available **ONLY** from the SA Uniform Shop)
- Plain black leggings** (available from the SA Uniform Shop)
